

BABRAHAM SCHOOL 50/50 CLUB

WHAT IS IT?

The Babraham 50/50 Club is a lottery club, designed to raise funds for Babraham School. It is administered by the Friends of Babraham School (FoBS), and was started in March 2008.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

You sign up for a 6-month or a 12-month subscription, at a cost of £1 per number per month, up to a maximum of 5 numbers. Each participant will be informed of their randomly-selected number(s) by FoBS. The same numbers are kept for the duration of a subscription. Payment is by cheque. Renewal reminders will be sent out in September (for 6-month subscriptions) and February (for 12-month subscriptions). Please see the table below for costs.

WHO CAN JOIN?

As we are a "Friends" society we are able to open this up to anyone with an interest in raising funds for the school. So please ask your family, neighbours and work colleagues if they would like to participate.

WHAT DO WE GET OUT OF IT?

Monthly draws are made, and 50% of the subscription monies will be used for the single cash prize. So the more numbers entered the bigger the prize. The other 50% goes to the Friends of Babraham School. The draws are made in public, for instance at the end of a school assembly where parents and other adults have been invited to attend, or a FoBS event. It is intended that an adult will always be asked to make the draw. If we are unable to make a draw, for instance in August when there is no school, then it will simply be postponed until the following month, and two draws will be performed consecutively.

WHAT DO I DO NEXT?

We need to undertake the September draw by the end of the month. So please make sure you send one of the attached forms, along with your cheque (made payable to 'Friends of Babraham School') for the relevant amount, back to school as soon as possible. Please ask as many people as you can if they would like to join in.
